Oakland-Bay Area Middle and High School Students in Grades 6 through 12

Essay Question

'How can I make my community a better place to live, work and grow?'

Civic Pride, Inc. is 501c(3) nonprofit volunteer youth-serving organization. Civic Pride developed its 'Five Pillars of Leadership and Responsible Citizenship™' which are:

Pillar #1: Character Development

Pillar #2: Civic Engagement

Pillar #3: Cultural Competency

Pillar #4: College Readiness

Pillar #5: Career Preparation

Rules for Middle School Students: Middle school students are to write a maximum 250 to 300-word essay about the benefits and reasons why volunteering in one's community is important, or how to make one's own community a better place to live, work and grow. Students are encouraged reflect on, and use their own civic engagement experiences as examples for demonstrating growth through learning.

Rules for High School Students: High school students are to write a maximum 350 to 500-word essay about the benefits and reasons why volunteering in one's community is important, or how to make one's own community a better place to live, work and grow. Students are encouraged reflect on, and use their own civic engagement experiences as examples for demonstrating growth through learning.

Entries will be judged on the following criteria: 1. Grade Level, 2. Adherence to Essay Guidelines, 3. Content and, 4. Writing Conventions.

Format: All entries must be typed, double-spaced and in 12-pitch. Contestants are to put name, age, grade, and contact information at the top of the page, followed by the contest essay.

Prizes and Awards: Essay Contest winners MUST attend the 'Knowledge Is Power' Youth Leadership Conference on Saturday, October 21, 2017 where cash awards, prizes and certificates will be distributed. A 'Certificate of Achievement' will be given each contestant submitting a qualifying entry at the Conference.
